An up-to-date immunisation statement must be provided prior to a boy starting Kindergarten. The School is required by law to keep a record of the vaccination status of all children enrolled. If a child leaves the school, a record of his vaccination status can be requested by his new school. Parents can request a copy of this record by calling the Australian Childhood Immunisation Register (ACIR) on 1800 653 809 or emailing acir@medicareaustralia.gov.au or visiting a Medicare office. If a child is unvaccinated due to a severe allergy or illness or parents have an objection to vaccination, an ACIR Immunisation Medical Exemption Form must be provided. Your GP can assist with this.

Special Needs

It is important that we understand any special needs or medical condition your son/ward may have in order to plan and provide support for his education.

Coogee Prep’s definition of ‘special needs’ applies to students who may have: learning difficulties, family problems, behavioural problems, problems associated with bullying, psychological and social difficulties, students who may have difficulties with the English language, students with specific religious or cultural observations, students with physical disabilities, medical or health risks and students who require medication for various reasons.

Coogee Prep acknowledges its responsibilities to provide quality outcomes for all students.
